Background

There is a significant need to strengthen existing focused training and technical assistance efforts in the field of substance abuse prevention and within communities by implementing culturally relevant, evidenced-based strategies and interventions.

In response, this project serves Substance Abuse Block Grant Prevention Professionals in North Carolina providing training and technical assistance services to the prevention field including professionals/pre-professionals, organizations, citizens, and others in the prevention community as identified by the North Carolina Division of Mental Health/Developmental Disabilities/Substance Abuse Services.



TTA Philosophy

The North Carolina Training and Technical Assistance (NCTTA) Center also believes that addressing the training and technical assistance needs for prevention professionals in North Carolina is paramount in attempts to build and retain a high quality and effective workforce.

In 2014, Pamela S. Hyde, while serving as the SAMHSA Administrator, stated a primary method of solving the shortage of behavioral healthcare professionals was to create systems of support that developed and disseminated workforce training, educational tools and core competencies. In support of such approaches the North Carolina Statewide Prevention Needs Assessment Report of Providers (2017), provided additional evidence of needed NCTTA related activities and focused expansion.



TTA Approach

- Developing tools and strategies to improve the quality of substance abuse prevention activities
- Providing technical assistance and learning resources
- Improving the understanding of prevention science
- Encouraging the use of epidemiological data to guide prevention planning
